



## 4th Annual UApresents Children's Festival

### Call for Organizations and Artists

The 4th Annual UApresents Children's Festival is coming soon! Sunday, January 29, 2012 from 1:00 pm – 3:30 pm. The festival will take place on the Centennial Hall patio right before the show Imago Theatre's *ZooZoo* at 4pm. We are looking for local organizations, artists, schools, UA departments and student clubs to host table with interactive activities and information about programs that serve children and families. We are also looking for performing artists and groups to do short (5-15 minute) performances.

We expect nearly 2,000 children and families to attend. Many UA campus organizations and artists will be there- creating interactive arts, crafts, science, education, and literature activities for children and families, providing information about services, camps, and classes, and performing. We are able to provide 1 to 3 six foot tables, plastic table cloths, chairs and limited access to electricity. We ask participants to arrive between 11am-12pm for set up and stay until the end of the festival at 3:30 pm. We ask performers to arrive 1 hour before their scheduled performance.

There is no cost to participate and it is a fantastic way to highlight all the things your department does for the Tucson community. Your organization's name will be included on the UApresents website and in flyers at the festival.
